EmComm-Training Operation "Ashfall" Semi-Annual Drill – After Action Report

I participated in the EmComm Training Semi-Annual Drill in May 14, 2022. The objectives were: Amateur radio stations, in an imaginary disaster scenario where the conventional infrastructure is compromised, will compose and send forms/emails using the Winlink "email over radio" system to ETO clearinghouses, create an added drill component to compose and send messages/forms by Winlink P2P ("Peer-to-Peer"), include additional tasks for participants in messaging, including the finding of additional information to be included or analyzed, continue to emphasize digital modes for achieving accuracy and timeliness of messaging, encourage partner organizations to participate in their own local operations during the drill, and prepare and train amateur radio operators to effectively use the Winlink system. I was successful in sending the proper form to both my ETO clearinghouse as well as one P2P target. It was my first Vara HF peer-to-peer attempt so I am pleased to see that work. In the future, I would like to attempt more P2P targets during the exercise to insure I am able to reach multiple targets. 

Hi, HOTARC!

McLennan County has experienced one Severe Thunderstorm Warning the last three months running. Even though we have experienced several dry months, we still get storms this time of year. We are entering Hurricane Season on June 1st. Early tropical storm forecasts are predicting between 16 and 21 named storms, six to nine hurricanes, with three to five major hurricanes for the upcoming season. The number of named storms looks to be above the 25-year average, and would be the seventh straight, above-average hurricane season. According to the U.S. National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the average for tropical cyclones in the Atlantic between 1991 and 2020 is seven hurricanes, three of them major, and 14 tropical storms.



As always, the ARES team is ready to deploy if needed. Thanks to everyone who is part of the team!

If you have a sincere desire to help, registration is necessary before the next emergency, not after it occurs. We are also beginning to include our 70 cm repeater 442.875 MHz (input at +5.0 MHz, tone 123 Hz).
