The ARES/Bakers Dozen Training Net is held **each Monday night at 8 PM on the 145.15 W5ZDN repeater**. Net Control volunteers typically operate from their home QTH. I would like to provide this excellent training opportunity to all current members of McLennan County ARES.

Current volunteers are KC5KNI and AC5JC. These individuals have done an excellent job running the Nets very smoothly this year, and have stepped up to the plate again for 2019. Now I need to hear from the rest of the 2018 Net Controls to determine if they want to participate again for 2019.

Again: if you want to participate, please let me know by 10 December 2018. This is really what amateur radio is all about—preparation for emergency service.
